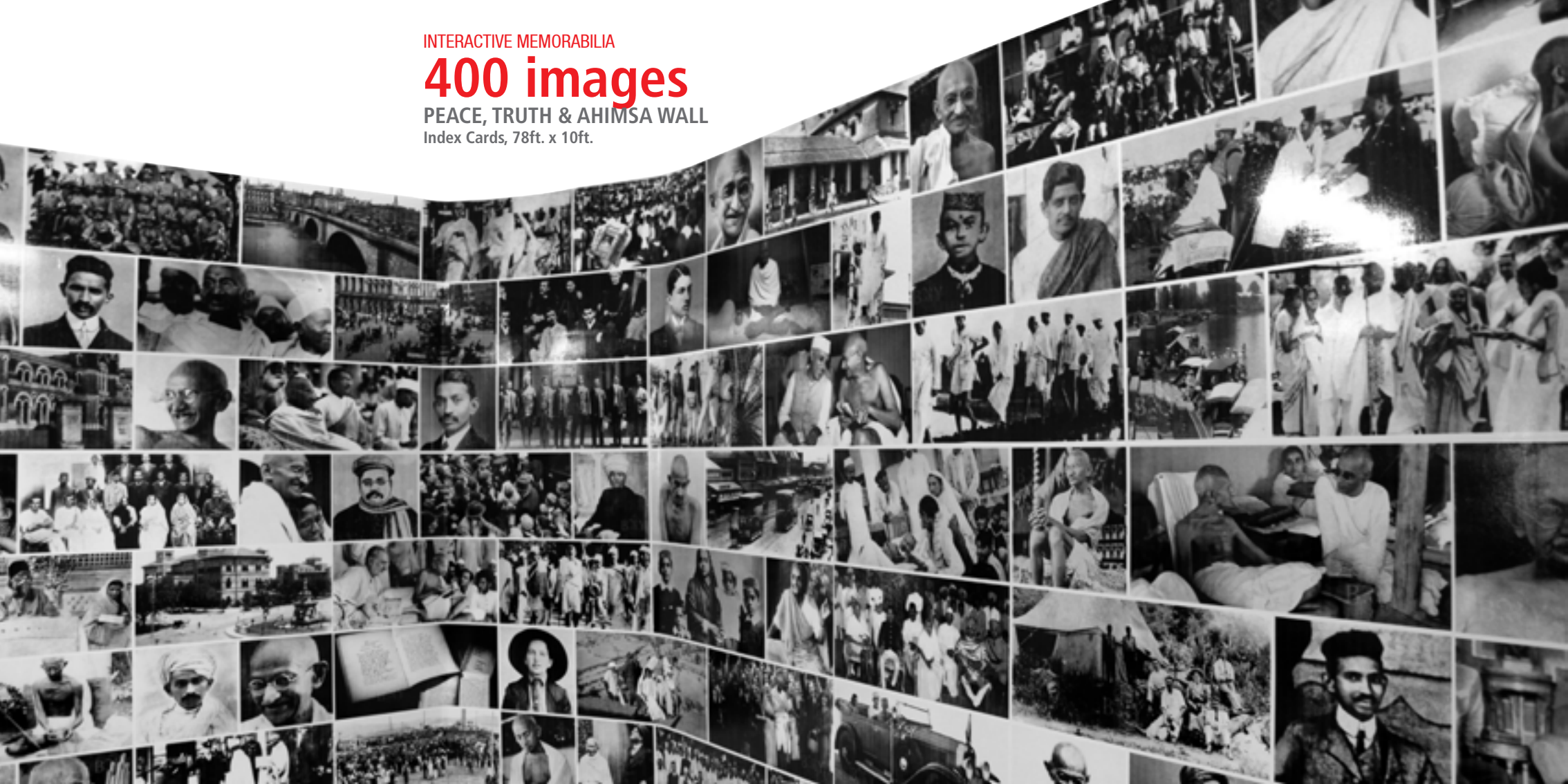

و معركة قتل وجرح فيها عدد كبير من الفريقين وستوالي نشرنا بعضا من مناظر هذه الحركة





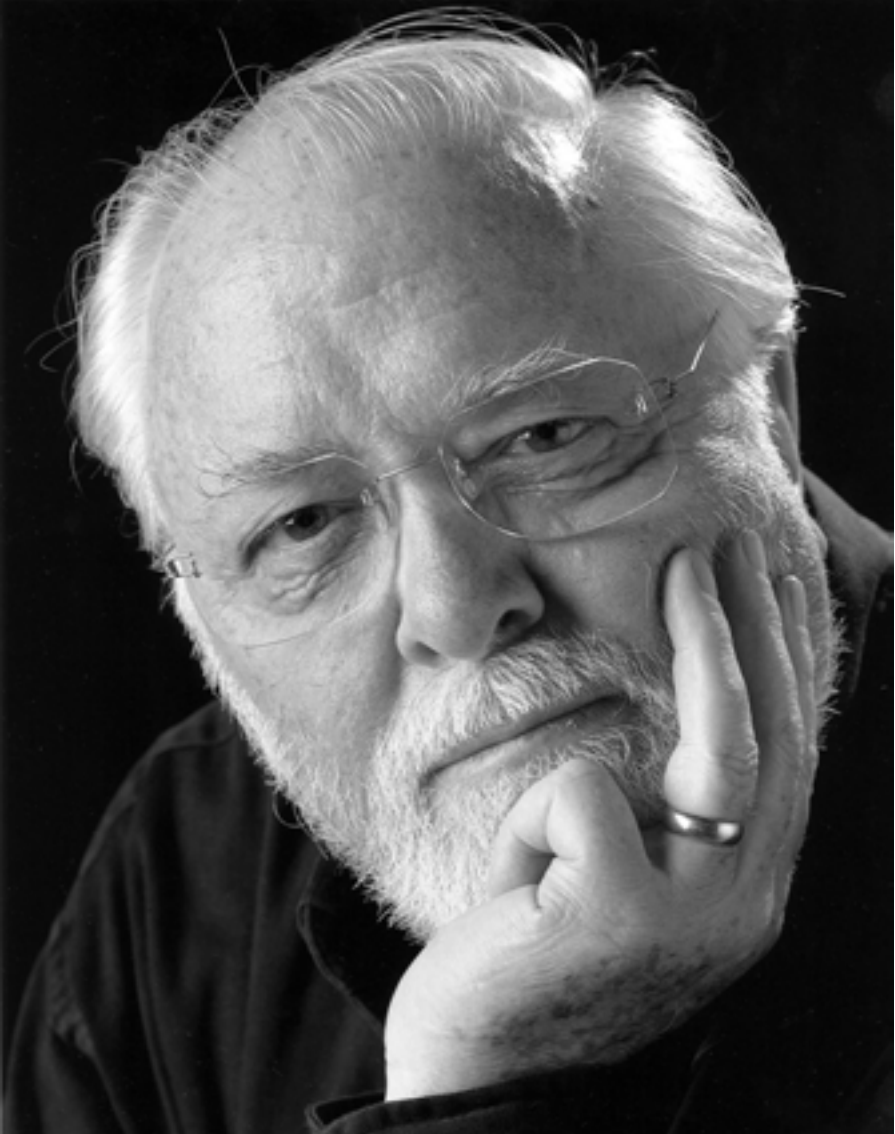

As an actor he is perhaps best known for his roles in Brighton Rock, The Great Escape, 10 Rillington Place, Miracle on 34th Street and Jurassic Park.
